HATTENG We recommend visiting the Aurora Spirit Distillery, which is the world's northernmost whisky distillery and is situated approx. 11 km from *Lyngseidet* (a 30-minute bike ride). You can go on a hike from Lyngseidet or rent a bike to reach other places.

In Olderdalen, you can go on hikes offering spectacular views of the Lyngen Alps.

• NORDKJOSBOTN The locals refer to Nordkiosbotn as Vollan. You can change buses here and travel further south towards Harstad and Narvik. Nordkjosbotn

From Hatteng, you can go on nice hikes and see the iconic mountain Otertind. From here, you can enter the Signaldalen valley and the border region to Sweden and Finland for endless hiking options.

SKIBOTN Skibotn is now known for its many

trails for hiking and mountain biking. road leads up to 750 m above sea From the centre of the village, you can easily walk or bike to the *Hengen* waterfall or the viewpoint at Svarteberget. The Skibotnutløpet Nature Reserve is a great place for birdwatching. We recommend a visit to the historic Skibotn Marketpla which was the largest and most important market in Northern Norway.

• BIRTAVARRE

Birtavarre is the gateway to Halti -Finland's highest mountain. A gravel level. On the way to Halti (27 km), vou should visit Ankerlia, the old mining community (10.6 km from Birtavarre), and the popular Gorsa bridge (14.3 km from Birtavarre). Adventurous visitors can bungy jump off the Gorsa bridge (open every Saturday during the summer).
